Wrap around Care

Part of our school's wrap around care service throughout the week offering in-house holiday and afterschool care, catering for children ages 3-11. For further information and a registration pack including prices can be provided by emailing: 1066holidayclub@stamfordbridgeschool.co.uk.

Hours

Childcare is available from 7.30am - 5.30pm (subject to wrap around care availability).

A full day nursery session is 6 ½ hours. 5 full day sessions at nursery equates to 32 ½ hours, therefore, resulting in parents/ carers paying for any extra hours above their childcare entitlement.

Prices

If you are not using your childcare hours at school, you can pay for the sessions you use. In line with East Riding recommendations, a session will be charged at £5.50 per hour.

Full day	8.30am - 3.00pm	Child is delivered to school by 8:30am. Child can be picked up from school at 3:00pm by parent/ carer or named person.
Morning session	8.30am - 12.00pm	Child is delivered to school by 8:30am. Child can be picked up from school at 12.00pm by parent/ carer or named person.
Morning session including a packed lunch or hot school meal (cost of £2.55)	8.30am - 1.00pm	Child is delivered to school by 8:30am. Child can be picked up from school at 1:00pm by parent/ carer or named person.
Afternoon session	1.00pm - 3:00pm	Child is delivered to school by 1:00pm. Child can be picked up from school at 3:00pm by by parent/ carer or named person.
Breakfast Club	7.30am - 8.30am	Child can attend breakfast club from 7.30am (at additional cost unless you choose to include this as part of your entitled hours).
After School Club	3.00pm - 4.00pm or 3.00pm - 5.30pm	Child can attend After School Club for either a short session (4pm finish) or long session (5.30pm finish) at an additional cost unless you chose to include this session as part of your child's entitled hours. Subject to availability.
