Intent

At Stamford Bridge Primary School, we believe that PSHE education enables our pupils to develop knowledge, skills and attributes needed to manage balanced lives and to become healthy, independent and responsible members of society. Across school, we teach children about how society is organised and governed and we ensure that they experience the process of democracy in school through the school council. We want children to understand their rights and responsibilities as an individual and show empathy and understanding to others.

In doing so, we help develop their sense of self-worth by encouraging them to play a positive role in school life and the wider community and prepare them for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of later life.

Implementation

At Stamford Bridge Primary School, we offer pupils a carefully planned programme using the **1decision scheme** to teach PSHE and RSE.

1 decision provides 17 modules, which are recommended for the teaching of PSHE and RSE for students in years 1-6. The core of the programme is a series of documentaries and videos with alternative endings, which enable children to explore various topics in a safe, educational environment. The 1 decision videos feature within their collection of over 70 on-screen lesson guides.

The 1decision resources have been developed over the past 12 years and were created by specialists working together with schools and, most importantly, children.

The 1 decision platform has been designed to be interactive, fun, and engaging for your child. At its core, is a series of short film clips with alternative endings, encouraging children to consider the consequences of different decisions.

The videos included in our content serve as a powerful tool for breaking down societal barriers, aiming to bridge the gaps that often divide us. These videos are driven by a profound commitment to promoting inclusivity and understanding among people from all walks of life. Teachers and children use these films alongside pupil workbooks and on-screen lesson guides to explore various topics in a safe and supportive learning environment.

Through storytelling and empathy, 1 decision encourages dialogue and mutual respect, dismantling barriers and promoting a more inclusive society. In a world where division can be all too common, 1 decision videos serve as a beacon of unity and understanding, reminding us that we are all part of a larger human family.





Assembly Packs Overview

The 1 decision assembly packs are comprehensive educational resources, mirroring the lesson structure, designed to empower students with essential life skills and values.

Across the academic year, we plot the 1decision assemblies into our assembly schedule to teach and explore the themes in larger groups in the hall.

These packs cover essential topics, such as celebrating differences, enhancing your emotional well-being and mindfulness tools that help children navigate through the challenges of growth and change. These assemblies promote critical thinking while encouraging open dialogue and equip pupils with the knowledge and confidence to make informed decisions.

PSHE and RSE Long Term Plans at Stamford Bridge Primary School

Below are the long-term plans for PSHE at Stamford Bridge School. Our school operates on a two-year rolling cycle, with the current academic year (2023-2024) being Cycle B and the following year (2024-2025) will be Cycle A. Each year is divided into three terms:

Autumn, Spring, and Summer. The plan outlines which topics will be taught and when for each year group throughout the academic year.

Additionally, you have access to knowledge organisers, which align with the topics and provide further detail on the objectives and vocabulary covered in their learning. These resources aim to provide you with a comprehensive understanding of the PSHE curriculum and the learning experiences your child will encounter at Stamford Bridge School.
